PA STATE LAW

- 1. Criminal Background Check -FREE for volunteers**
- 2. Child Abuse – FREE for volunteers**
- 3. Fingerprints don't need to be done if you are a resident of PA for more than 10 year.**

In order to come into the school, you must have valid clearances on file. This includes classroom parties, field trips, and any event during the school day where you are interacting with any student in the building.

On the Fleetwood Website under forms and links you can find the information. It all needs to be sent to the office and kept on file before you can come into the school or volunteer in the classroom. The district keeps them on file for 5 years and you are responsible for keeping track of your dates.
